Liverpool city council want to clear the city of fat pigeons. They say that people are feeding the birds, which makes them fat. The pigeons get bigger because their normal diet would consist of seeds and insects, not high-fat junk food they are eating in the city center. The council want people to know that everyone who feeds the pigeons is responsible for the streets being so crowded with these birds. They hope to encourage the birds to move away from the city center and into parks and open spaces. Ten robotic birds have been brought into the city center to scare the pigeons away and visitors are asked not to give the pigeons any food. The mechanical birds - known as 'robots' - will sit on the roofs of buildings. They can be moved around to different locations. They look like a peregrine falcon, which is a bird that kills pigeons. They even make noises and flap their wings to scare the pigeons. They hope that the pigeons will go away before the city becomes the European Capital of Culture in two years.

Dolphins are marine mammals that are related to whales and other sea animals. A marine mammal is one that lives in the water. Dolphins are found all over the world's oceans as well as in seas, lakes and rivers. Dolphins are carnivores (meat eaters) and feed on fish, squid (a sea creature with a long body) and other marine life. They often swim together in groups called "pods." They are thought to have powerful eyesight and hearing, but do not have a sense of smell. Dolphins come in different sizes. Some are smaller than the average person, but others, such as the orca, can be 30 feet long, or more than five times as long as the average person. Dolphins are thought to be very intelligent and communicate with each other using short, sharp sounds and whistles. All dolphins are powerful swimmers. Have you ever seen a dolphin? Groups of dolphins can often be seen moving up down quickly in and out of waves close to the shoreline.

Indira married Feroze Gandhi in 1942. The couple had two sons Rajiv and Sanjay. Her husband died of a heart attack in 1960 and Sanjay – who was destined to be her political heir – perished in a plane crash in 1980. Devastated by the loss of Sanjay, Indira persuaded a reluctant Rajiv to quit his job and enter into politics. After his mother's assassination in 1984, he served as Indian Prime Minister from 1984-89. Indira Gandhi was a rare example of a woman rising to the most powerful position in Indian society. She did not consider herself a feminist but was concerned with issues relating to women and she saw her own success as proof that talented women could rise to the top. During her administration, equal pay for men and women was enshrined in the constitution. In a speech on "True Liberation of Women", March 26, 1980, she said: "To be liberated, woman must feel free to be herself, not in rivalry to man but in the context of her own capacity and her personality." She also sought to mobilize Indian woman for the cause of Indian Independence.
